PACK A PICNIC LIKE NEVER BEFORE

Whether you're basking in the sun at the beach, lounging in a park, or exploring a scenic trail, these delicious and easy-to-prepare recipes can turn any outing into a memorable adventure. Gather your loved ones or enjoy some peaceful solitude with these delightful picnic dishes!

MEDITERRANEAN PASTA

- 12 oz pasta (rotini or penne)
- · 1 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
- 1 cucumber, diced
- 1/4 cup fresh parsley, chopped
- 1/2 cup Kalamata olives- pitted, halved
- 1/2 cup feta cheese, crumbled
- 1/2 red onion, thinly sliced
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- · 2 tbsp red wine vinegar
- 1 tsp dried oregano
- · Salt and pepper to taste

Cook pasta according to package instructions. Drain and let cool. In a large bowl, combine the cooled pasta, cherry tomatoes, cucumber, red onion, olives, feta cheese, and parsley. In a small bowl, whisk together the olive oil, red wine vinegar, oregano, salt, and pepper. Pour dressing over the pasta salad, toss to combine. Chill in refrigerator at least 1 hr before serving.

LEMON MINT ICED TEA

- 8 cups water
- 6 black tea bags
- 1 cup fresh mint leaves
- 1/2 cup honey or sugar
- · 1 cup fresh squeezed lemon juice (about 4-5 lemons)

Boil water then remove from heat. Add tea and mint leaves, steep for 10 min, Remove tea bags and mint leaves. Stir in honey or sugar. Let the tea cool to room temp. Add lemon juice. Chill 2 hours. Serve over ice, garnish with lemon slices and mint leaves.

CHICKEN CAESAR WRAPS

- · 2 cups cooked chicken breast. diced
- 1/2 cup Caesar dressing
- 1/4 cup grated Parmesan
- · 2 cups romaine lettuce, chopped
- · 4 large tortillas or wraps

In large bowl, combine cooked chicken, Caesar dressing, Parmesan cheese, and chopped romaine lettuce. Lay out the tortillas and divide the chicken mixture evenly among them. Roll up each tortilla tightly and wrap in foil or plastic wrap for easy transport. Keep chilled until ready to serve.

CAPRESE SKEWERS


- 1 pint cherry tomatoes
- 8 oz fresh mozzarella balls

- Salt and pepper

Thread cherry tomatoes, mozzarella balls, and basil leaves onto skewers. Be sure to alternate ingredients. Drizzle with balsamic glaze. Add salt and pepper. Serve chilled or room temperature.


